

What is the Comprehensive Care Sustainability Collaborative (CCSC)?

- A quality improvement and cost management initiative sponsored by the National Bleeding Disorders Foundation (NBDF)
- The aim is to provide a framework for pilot programs between payers and hemophilia treatment centers (HTCs) to facilitate cost-effective hemophilia management that integrates the HTC comprehensive care model

CCSC Objectives

- Advance the collaboration between payers and federally recognized HTCs to enable patient access to high quality care while payers can potentially reduce their overall spend
- Collect data validating collaborative relationships between payers and HTCs that mutually benefits all parties involved, including patients/members

Benefits of CCSC Participation

- Overcome communication gaps with payers pertaining to the management of hemophilia patients, role of Federal Drug Discount Program, and value of the comprehensive care model
- Increased connectivity with payer stakeholders by sharing quantitative data that provides a distinct opportunity for quality improvement and a selling point for payer contract negotiations
- National recognition for a commitment to quality improvement in hemophilia management
